The Parish Council is delighted to announce that DK9 Security have commenced security patrols within the village.



The security patrols take place 7 days a week (but not on bank holidays, Christmas Day or Boxing Day) from 6pm to midnight. The patrols will be carried out by a DK9 security guard, patrol car and a guard dog.

Land at Kirby Rise – Proposed Play Area

Barham Parish Council has funding available from the Mid Suffolk District Council Section 106 funding. This money can only be spent on play/sports equipment and we would like to put it to good use. As you are no doubt aware Barham, does not currently have any recreation space within the village itself, but shares the recreation ground facilities in Claydon.

It has been brought to the attention of the Parish Council that an area of land at Kirby Rise is currently owned by Mid Suffolk's Housing Revenue Account. We feel that this area of land in the village, might be appropriate to have a small play area which would benefit the community. The funding available from MSDC would be enough to purchase at least 4 small pieces of play equipment.

The Parish Council sent out a questionnaire to the residents of Kirby Rise to measure the level of interest for the proposed play area. If you did not receive a questionnaire and would like to offer your comments then please contact the Clerk. Thank you to those who have returned the questionnaire.

Community Infrastructure Levy - CILs

In October the Parish Council received £537.34 CIL's money and this was used towards the purchase of the vehicle activated speed sign which is located on Norwich Road. SCC John Field has offered funding towards the sign. The Parish Council are also in the process of applying for a 2nd VAS sign, to be placed the opposite end of Norwich Road. SCC John Field, MSDC Tim Passmore & John Whitehead have all offered to help fund the 2nd sign.
