As for myself I have been the Deputy Headteacher at Claydon High School for the last five years, therefore I know the school and community well and look forward to driving us forwards.

Talking about moving forwards I can share that I have also been appointed as the Executive Headteacher of the Claydon Campus. What's the Claydon Campus I hear you ask? We had the remarkable opportunity of both the high school and primary school headships being up at the same time. Through discussions with Sarah Skinner (CEO Penrose Learning Trust) we decided it was about time we joined both schools. This means we will be one of the first Reception to GCSE mainstream schools in the county. Both myself and Mrs O'Connor are incredibly excited by this opportunity.
